

Diagnosics and Nutrition for People with HPV



The Human Papillomavirus (HPV) which infects the genital tract has been linked to cervical cancer in women. Breakspear Hospital has developed a tampon-based diagnostic test to provide women with a means of both confirming HPV infection and the HPV sub-type. Some HPV sub-types (such as HPV 16, 18 and 23) are linked to cervical cancer; therefore it is important, under medical supervision, to be aware of the HPV sub-type. In terms of treatment modalities, Mycology Research Laboratories and Breakspear Hospital have focused on the use of both *Coriolus versicolor* and folic acid supplementation to assist the body's immune system to clear the HPV virus.
